FUNCTION & APPLICATION: A complete parts cleaning kit, including parts basket and an effective solvent cleaner formulated to thoroughly clean metal parts in the home, garage, and shop.

OUTSTANDING PROPERTIES: Environmentally responsible. This product has been formulated to reduce or eliminate adverse environmental characteristics. It is Non-Corrosive, and contains No Ozone Depleters, No Chlorinated Solvents, No Phenols, and No Cresylics. Removes carbon, grease, oil, varnish, paint, and grime deposits.

PRODUCT LIMITATIONS: Do not place gasket, rubber or plastic parts in the solution.

USE DIRECTIONS: Works best at room temperature. 1) Place parts to be cleaned into parts basket. 2) Lower basket into solution. Parts must be completely submerged. 3) Allow parts to soak for 20 minutes. 4) Brush heavy soil deposits, if necessary. 5) Rinse parts in water. Use care to avoid splashing on any painted or non-metallic surfaces. 6) Dry parts thoroughly before re-assembly. 7) Replace cover until ready to reuse solution.

PRECAUTIONS: Contains (CAS#) Aromatic Petroleum Distillates (64742-94-5), 2-Butoxy Ethanol (111-76-2), Triethanolamine (102-71-6). Combustible. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Eye and skin irritant. Vapors harmful.

FIRST AID: If swallowed, give large quantity of water or milk. Do not induce vomiting. Call Poison Control Center, Physician, or Hospital Emergency Room Immediately. For eye contact, flush thoroughly with water for 15 minutes while lifting eyelids and get prompt medical attention. For skin contact, wash thoroughly with soap and water.
